Will you kindly inform me whether any magnetic observations have been made at Trinity College since the time when the Magnetic Observatory was in operation. I have the results of the observations made by Thorpe at the College in 1887 in connection with the Magnetic Survey of Great Britain, but have none between the last of Lloyd's in 1850 and those ~~ma~~ made by Thorpe, nor any subsequent to Thorpe's. I am making a collection of all observations made at Dublin and should therefore be greatly obliged to you if you would kindly furnish me with the values of the period referred to. Is the Magnetic Observatory still in existence and is any attempt made at carrying on systematic work? I desire this information for eventual publication in "Terrestrial Magnetism", of which I take pleasure in sending you a sample copy.
