Dear George

Very many thanks for

Belfast - for which I was
not sorry.

recently imported one of those
Perfollet Cannoses which is the
wonder (& sometimes horror) of the

neighbours. I have been
asked to exhibit it in
the Waterworks Park here
on 18th April & in order to
make the show more imposing
& interesting I have been
endeavouring to get some of
the English ^{agents or owners of} carriages ^{to send}
there are - One firm "Acme
Co" offers to send a carriage
if we will pay £25
but that is rather high
for us & it struck me
we might combine a show
in Dublin & so write to
ask if any of the Societies
you are connected with
would organise such a thing
The Acme people say they
are wanted in Cork also.

Dublin should not be
left out & doubtless we
could the more easily get
other carriages of three cities
joined. I have not had
replies from any other people
who own carriages yet but
am in hopes to get one more
