I have often wanted to use a lead roof  
or something of that sort, but the job is to  
get anything <sup>already up;</sup> <sup>enough.</sup> <sup>possibly the area would</sup>  
<sup>best set up on end</sup>  
<sup>for a distant reach given.</sup>

No doubt the coils <sup>do as you say</sup> diminish the radiating power but  
they are great for tuning. <sup>they follow the vibration direction</sup>

Squeezing the coils of the receiver closer together puts it out of  
tune, using a coil of fewer or of more turns  
also puts it out of tune, with a constant emitter.  
The emitter has interchangable coils, one for each receiving station.
