conduction fits in very nicely  
into the equations. I think

Maxwell's use of  $(F, E, H)$  is obscure  
and, <sup>perhaps</sup> wrong in principle when  
displacement currents are  
important.

It is only the comment in your  
letter that give me an excuse  
of inflicting them on you.
