I have been recalled
by my patent agent in connection
with U.S. patent. McDonough
feeling to get interference on his
-92 patent has applied
for a patent identical with
mine and is resorting to the
plan of "swearing back" as
it is termed. He has to
get anyone to testify that
before Aug 9th - 94 he had

disclosed the invention to him.
This would mean "discovery"
in America before me as
Aug 9-94 is date of my U.S.
application. Absurd as this
may sound it puts my patent
in serious danger - for Built says
that the law there is altogether
in favor of U.S. citizens and
where it can be done
patents are believed in their
favor. Now although Mr D.
will be quite prepared to
swear back to Aug 9th 94
if my invention was in any
way brought into U.S. before

that date he will be cut
out. The fact that I had
protection in England dating
from Apr 17th 53 is no avail
to me. 3/23
