be difficult to discover greater

E. Wiedemann is always translated
between ourselves E. W. is a perfect
charlatan & treated as such in
Germany. — I like him well enough
personally & have no feeling against
him but his papers are certainly
not worth translation. —

There are some papers which come
out in the Berlin Academy Monatshefte
often published there & these are not

early accessible & should therefore have
the preference if translation could
be made. —

My own feeling is that the interests
of the Brit. Soc. both at home & abroad
would best be served if they instead
of translating ^{foreign papers} they would reprint
some of the out-of-way English papers,
like those of the Edinburgh R.S.
