Dear Fry.

I am sending you the Engineering School lists.

The students can't rise from class to class without passing exams. so that the list of the classes are the same as the exam. lists. These latter would be more complex if we recorded here whether they passed in Trinity or partly in Trin. and partly in Mich. or wholly in Mich. and that is of little interest so that I fancy the class lists are the best to publish.

You will see the way I have entered the Degree Examination and Special certs. into (a) (b) (c) referring to the three special certificates. This seems much simpler than keeping a special separate list of the special certificates in each year and more

convenient for reference because it saves the double reference to the Degree list to find if a person was qualified for the Degree and then to another list to find whether they had obtained a special certificate.
